Last May, the MRC of Matawinie unveiled its new logo. This renewed image represented the ideal opportunity to review the various communication tools of the Transport Department that you will find attached to this bulletin. We invite you to carefully consult this bulletin in which you will find **several new features** and a wealth of information concerning paratransit service.

The Transportation Service has reached a level of ridership comparable to that before the pandemic, i.e. more than 21 000 trips will be made in 2023, with 975 users. In order to limit the spread of viruses to the population and in the transport service, we ask you to remain viligant during your travels if you have different flu symptoms.

# VISIT FRIENDS AND FAMILY THIS HOLIDAY SEASON

Once again this year, the Matawinie MRC is offering paratransit customers the chance to travel anywhere in the Lanaudière region, for a one-month period from December 15, 2023 to January 15, 2024 inclusive. Reservations for these dates must be made in accordance with the MRC Transport Department's usual reservation procedure.

After receipt of travel requests, they will be analyzed and carried out according to vehicle availability. The service reserves the right to refuse trips due to lack of personnel. The fare used will be that of the Matawinie MRC's paratransit service, plus the fare of the paratransit service used.

# FREE ADMISSION

Once again, this year, the MRC de Matawinie if offering paratransit customers the opportunity to travel anywhere in Lanaudière, for a period of one month, **from December 15 2023 to January 15 2024**. Reservations for these dates must be made according to the usual reservation procedure of the MRC Transport Department

## **NEW RATES**

As of January 1, 2024, a new fee schedule will be in effect. You can consult it now, as it is included in this mailing. We remind you that you must pay your right of way with the exact amount. There will be no refunds from the carrier.

# **REMINDER**

#### **SNOW STORMS**

If the Samares School Service Center is closed, all travel will be cancelled except for medical care and work, unless otherwise notified.

At all times, it is your

#### **ACCESS TO PREMISES**

responsibility to keep access to your home cleared and icefree (entrance, sidewalk, stairs, access ramp etc.). You must also ensure that access to the place where you are going will be clear. If you notice that access is blocked, you must cancel your trip as soon as possible, otherwise your transport will be cancelled and considered a cancellation at the door.

# **CALL RECORDING**

In order to maintain the quality of the service offered, we would like to remind you that all calls made during opening hours are recorded.

## **DEPARTURE TIME**

You must always be ready 15 minutes before the requested time of your reservation. If we have to advance or delay your departure by more than 16 minutes, we will call you the day before to let you know.

#### **NEW - IN THE EVENT OF CANCELLATION**

Over the past year, the Transportation Service has experienced a nearly 30% increase in late cancellations or no-shows during same-day pickup, leading to an increase in unsubsidized expenses.

We remind you that you must cancel as quickly as possible any trip that you do not plan to use. The following penalties could be applied to the next trip or billed at the end of the month.

# **RESERVATIONS**

To make a travel request, you must contact the \*Reservation Center at **450-386-1160** during the following hours:

Monday to Thursday from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and Friday form 8 a.m. to noon. Outside of these hours, you can only call to report a delay, cancel a trip or for a return call; no reservations will be accepted. Do not forget to have your addresses in hand when you call.

As of January 12, 2024, the Reservation Center will close at noon on Fridays

The following table presents the maximum time to make your travel reservations:

For all trips from TUESDAY to FRIDAY

No later than 2 p.m. the day before

For all trips for SATURDAY, SUNDAY and MONDAY

No later than Friday before 10 a.m.
